RULES

- Baking exhibits that do not win prizes may be removed between 10:00 am and 12 noon Saturday July 25. Check with the Director in Charge first. Any unclaimed baking will be donated to the kitchen.
 - All entries must be in between 1 – 3:30 pm on Friday July 24th
- NOTE: All baking entries must be on foil or paper plates. Staple tags to plates. Only one entry per person, per section. All baked goods made with commercial mixes, fillings, or shells will be disqualified.
